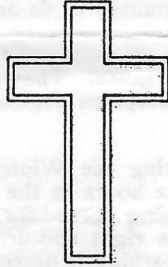

**Provided**, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to grant any other right or privilege whatever than the right of burial therein; that the said right shall not extend to the burial of any deceased person who shall have departed this life not in communion with the Catholic Church; and provided further, that this Certificate is issued and accepted by the person named herein with the express understanding and agreement that no body interred in the grave herein mentioned shall be removed for final reinterment in any Cemetery not a Catholic Cemetery.

**Furthermore:** This Certificate is not assignable without the consent in writing of the Supervisor of St. Charles' Cemetery.

All burials should be inscribed in the list of interments. The Cemetery will cooperate in making these records, but can only guarantee accuracy with its own office records.
