Judge Clancy, Appointed In February by Peabody

SPRINGFIELD — District Court Judge Donald A. Clancy, died in his sleep Sunday morning at his home, 141 Newton rd. He was 47.

Appointed to the bench by Gov. Peabody last February, Judge Clancy had been in good health, according to relatives.

He presided Saturday morning at the criminal session of the court.

A native of Springfield, he was a graduate of Boston College and its Law School. He served as city solicitor prior to the bench appointment.

During World War II he served as a military intelligence officer.

In addition to his wife, Mae, he leaves two daughters, Christine and Mary.

A solemn requiem Mass will be sung in Holy Cross Church Wednesday at 10 a.m. Burial
