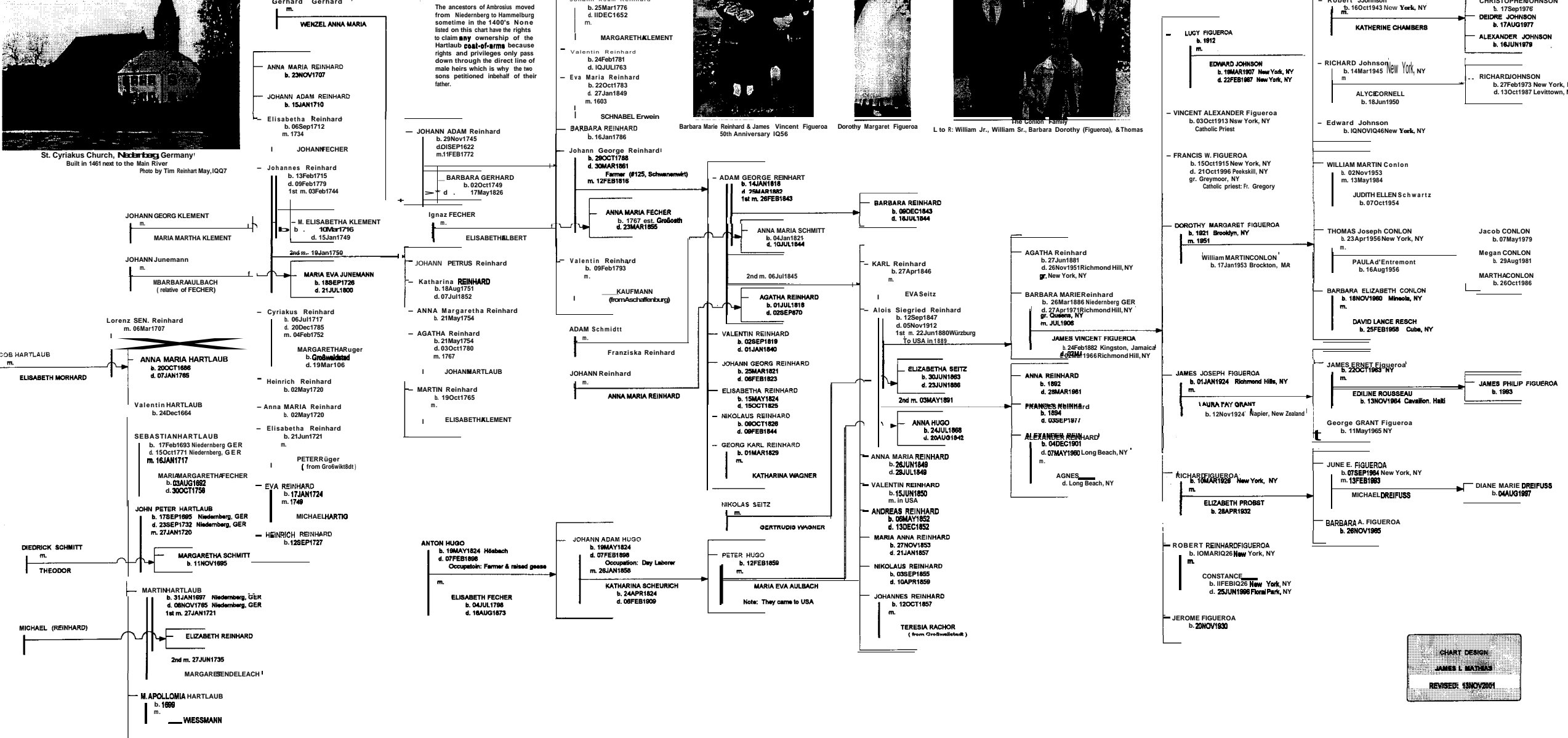

The Hartlaub Coat-of-Arms  
Ambrosius Hartlaub (d. 1607) served as mayor of Hammelburg, GER. He was awarded posthumously 8 coat-of-arms for his service to the community. His sons Johan Hartlaub (1597 - 1652) and Herman Hartlaub who had moved to Schweinfurt, GER were the ones who applied for and actually received the coat-of-arms

The ancestors of Ambrosius moved from Niedernberg to Hammelburg sometime in the 1400's. None listed on this chart have the rights to claim any ownership of the Hartlaub coat-of-arms because rights and privileges only pass down through the direct line of male heirs which is why the two sons petitioned in behalf of their father.
