MOHAMMED V, SULTAN OF TURKEY of whom I have heretofore been a subject (or subjects), an order of nobility, which I have heretofore held, and that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America against all enemies foreign and domestic; and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.
